

# LITTLE APPLE DAY CAMP

The following is included in the cost of Little Apple Day Camp: all snacks, milk and juice, swimming, splash park, Beach Museum of Art and Library trips, pottery and crafts, local and out-of-town field trips and transportation, special events and activities, tournaments and prizes, incentives and rewards/awards, LADC t-shirt, and swim shirt. The swim shirt will be required wear for all swimming activities.

Children must be registered in their specific current grade and they must have completed Kindergarten. We will place campers in appropriate age groups.



**Camp will consist of two four-week sessions and a shorter holiday session for the week of July 4th.**

**Session 1 Camp:** June 3-28 (all inclusive, except for swim lessons) \$400

**Holiday Session:** July 1-3 (all inclusive) \$60

**Session 2 Camp:** July 8-August 2 (all inclusive, except for swim lessons) \$400

**Each session will include one off-site local activity per week and one out-of-town field trip, except the holiday session.**

**Grades K-4 will have Manhattan Library activities and Beach Museum of Art activities, and grades 5-7 will have community service activities.**

from 10:00 a.m.-12:00 noon!*

**Payment Policy:**

At the time of enrollment, \$200 is due for the first session enrolled in, with a \$20 deposit to hold the other session. Sessions must be paid in full within five working days prior to the first day of that camp session. No refunds or prorating for partially used sessions

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** All KDHE forms must be complete and turned in at the time of enrollment - "Health History for Children & Youth Attending School Age Programs", "Authorization for Emergency Medical Care" (must be signed and notarized), "Authorization for Self-Administration of Medication for Children & Youth in School Age Programs" (sunscreens), and "Parental Permission Form".
